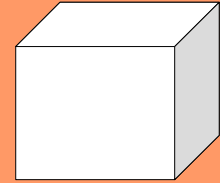


# Day of the Lord



Sunset	Silence in heaven for half hour; then voices, lightning, thunder Jesus coronation in heaven with “many crowns” as King of kings
Midnight	Resurrection & Rapture of Saints in “the twinkling of an eye” Jesus, the Breaker, destroys those attacking Bozrah/Petra
Sunrise	Jesus splits Mount of Olives in two so Jews can escape, and destroys enemies there before heading to Armageddon
Noon	Saints ride with Jesus to battle (Rev. 19:17)
Sunset	Antichrist and his armies defeated – Fowls feast on their flesh
Midnight	Dead are judged (Rev. 11:18)
Sunrise	
Noon	Beast and False Prophet into Lake of Fire – Satan bound Heaven & Earth destroyed by fire
Sunset	Bride in <b>New Jerusalem</b> with wealth of the nations (Zech 14:14) Wedding feast and rewards (first 7 days of 1,000 years)

# New Jerusalem



Revelation 21:9-17 “<sup>9</sup>And there came to me one of the seven angels which had the seven vials full of the seven last plagues, and talked with me, saying, Come here, I will show you the bride, the Lamb's wife. <sup>10</sup>And he carried me away in the spirit to a great and high mountain, and showed me that great city, the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God, <sup>11</sup>Having the glory of God: and her light was like to a stone most precious, even like a jasper stone, clear as crystal; <sup>12</sup>And had a wall great and high, and had twelve gates, and at the gates twelve angels, and names written thereon, which are the names of the twelve tribes of the children of Israel: <sup>13</sup>On the east three gates; on the north three gates; on the south three gates; and on the west three gates. <sup>14</sup>And the wall of the city had twelve foundations, and in them the names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb. <sup>15</sup>And he that talked with me had a golden reed to measure the city, and the gates thereof, and the wall thereof. <sup>16</sup>And the city lies foursquare, and the length is as large as the breadth: and he measured the city with the reed, twelve thousand furlongs. The length and the breadth and the height of it are equal. <sup>17</sup>And he measured the wall thereof, an hundred and forty and four cubits, according to the measure of a man, that is, of the angel.”

# Jesus comes to reward His servants

Revelation 11:15-18 “<sup>15</sup>And the seventh angel sounded; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord, and of his Christ; and he shall reign for ever and ever. <sup>16</sup>And the four and twenty elders, which sat before God on their seats, fell on their faces, and worshipped God, <sup>17</sup>Saying, We give you thanks, O LORD God Almighty, which are, and were, and are to come; because you have taken to you your great power, and have reigned.  
<sup>18</sup>And the nations were angry, **and your wrath is come**, and the time of the **dead**, that they should be **judged**, and that you should **give reward to your servants** the prophets, and to the saints, and them that fear your name, small and great; **and should destroy them which destroy the earth.**”

# Fleshly works will be burned

1 Corinthians 3:11-15 “<sup>11</sup>For other foundation can no man lay than that is laid, which is Jesus Christ. <sup>12</sup>Now if any man build on this foundation gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, stubble; <sup>13</sup>Every man's work shall be made manifest: for **the day** shall declare it, because it shall be revealed by fire; and the fire shall try every man's work of what sort it is. <sup>14</sup>If any man's work abide which he has built thereupon, he shall receive a reward. <sup>15</sup>If any man's work shall be burned, he shall suffer loss: but he himself shall be saved; yet so as by

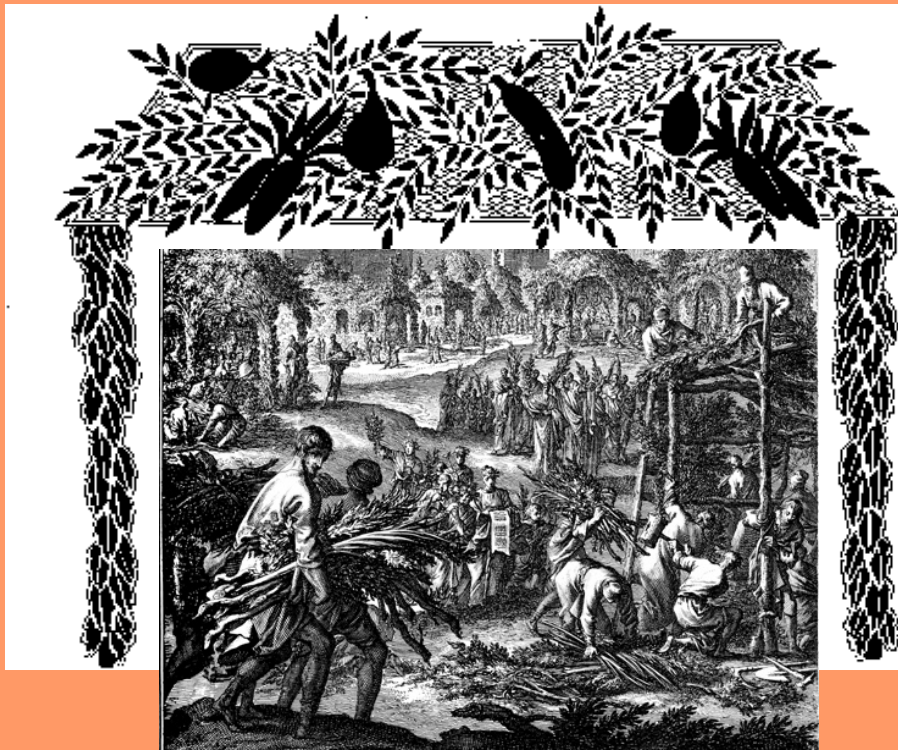


# New heaven and new earth

Revelation 21:1-4 “<sup>1</sup>And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea. <sup>2</sup>And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. <sup>3</sup>And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, and be their God. <sup>4</sup>And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away.”



# Feast of Booths on Mount Zion



Isaiah 25:6-10a “<sup>6</sup>And in this mountain shall the LORD of hosts make to all people a feast of fat things, a feast of wines on the lees, of fat things full of marrow, of wines on the lees well refined. <sup>7</sup>And he will destroy in this mountain the face of the covering cast over all people, and the veil that is spread over all nations. <sup>8</sup>He will swallow up death in victory; and the Lord GOD will wipe away tears from off all faces; and the rebuke of his people shall he take away from off all the earth: for the LORD has spoken it. <sup>9</sup>And it shall be said in that day, See, this is our God; we have waited for him, and he will save us: this is the LORD; we have waited for him, we will be glad and rejoice in his salvation. <sup>10</sup>For in this mountain shall the hand of the LORD rest”

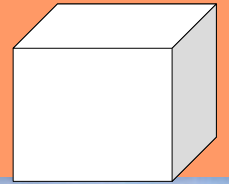

# New Jerusalem is a new 'moon'

Revelation 21:22-27 “<sup>22</sup>And I saw no temple therein: for the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are the temple of it. <sup>23</sup>And the city had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it: for the glory of God did lighten it, and the Lamb is the light thereof. <sup>24</sup>And the nations of them which are saved shall walk in the light of it: and the kings of the earth do bring their glory and honor into it. <sup>25</sup>And the gates of it shall not be shut at all by day: for there shall be no night there. <sup>26</sup>And they shall bring the glory and honor of the nations into it. <sup>27</sup>And there shall in no wise enter into it any thing that defiles, neither whatever works abomination, or makes a lie: but they which are written in the Lamb's book of life. ”



# Long life with children on new earth

Isaiah 65:17-25 “<sup>17</sup>For, behold, I create new heavens and a new earth: and the former shall not be remembered, nor come into mind. <sup>18</sup>But be you glad and rejoice for ever in that which I create: for, behold, I create Jerusalem a rejoicing, and her people a joy. <sup>19</sup>And I will rejoice in Jerusalem, and joy in my people: and the voice of weeping shall be no more heard in her, nor the voice of crying. <sup>20</sup>There shall be no more there an infant of days, nor an old man that has not filled his days: for the child shall die an hundred years old; but the sinner being an hundred years old shall be accursed. <sup>21</sup>And they shall build houses, and inhabit them; and they shall plant vineyards, and eat the fruit of them. <sup>22</sup>They shall not build, and another inhabit; they shall not plant, and another eat: for as the days of a tree are the days of my people, and my elect shall long enjoy the work of their hands. <sup>23</sup>They shall not labor in vain, nor bring forth for trouble; for they are the seed of the blessed of the LORD, and their offspring with them. <sup>24</sup>And it shall come to pass, that before they call, I will answer; and while they are yet speaking, I will hear. <sup>25</sup>The wolf and the lamb shall feed together, and the lion shall eat straw like the bullock: and dust shall be the serpent's meat. They shall not hurt nor destroy in all my holy mountain, said the LORD.”

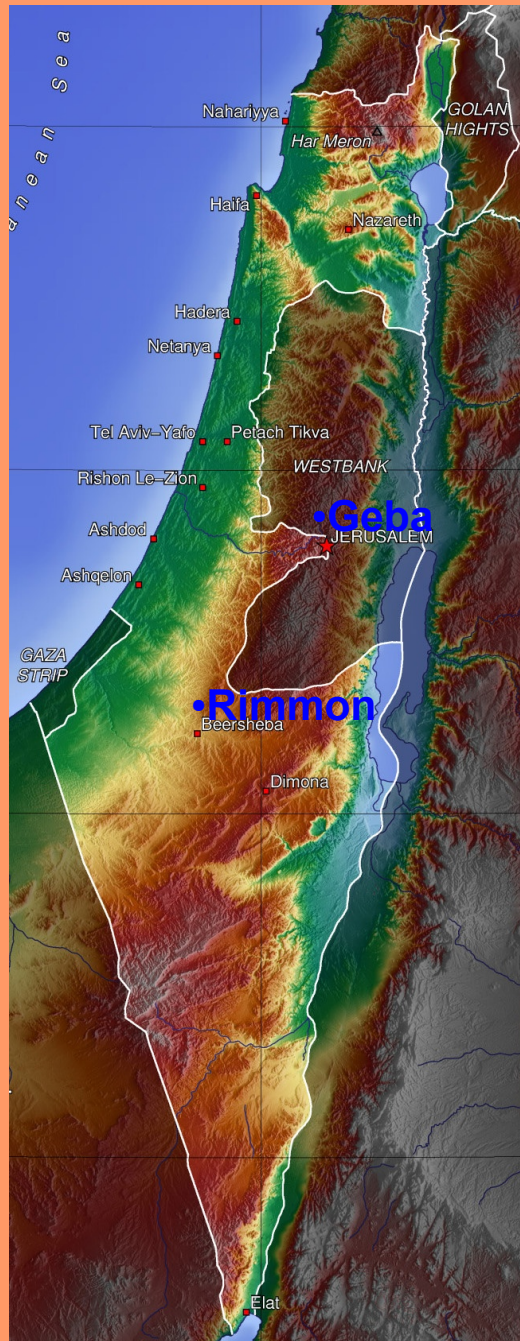
# We reign with Christ 1,000 years



Revelation 20:4-6 “<sup>4</sup>And I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and judgment was given to them: and I saw the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received his mark on their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years. <sup>5</sup>But the rest of the dead lived not again until the thousand years were finished. This is the first resurrection. <sup>6</sup>Blessed and holy is he that has part in the first resurrection: on such the second death has no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with him a thousand years.”



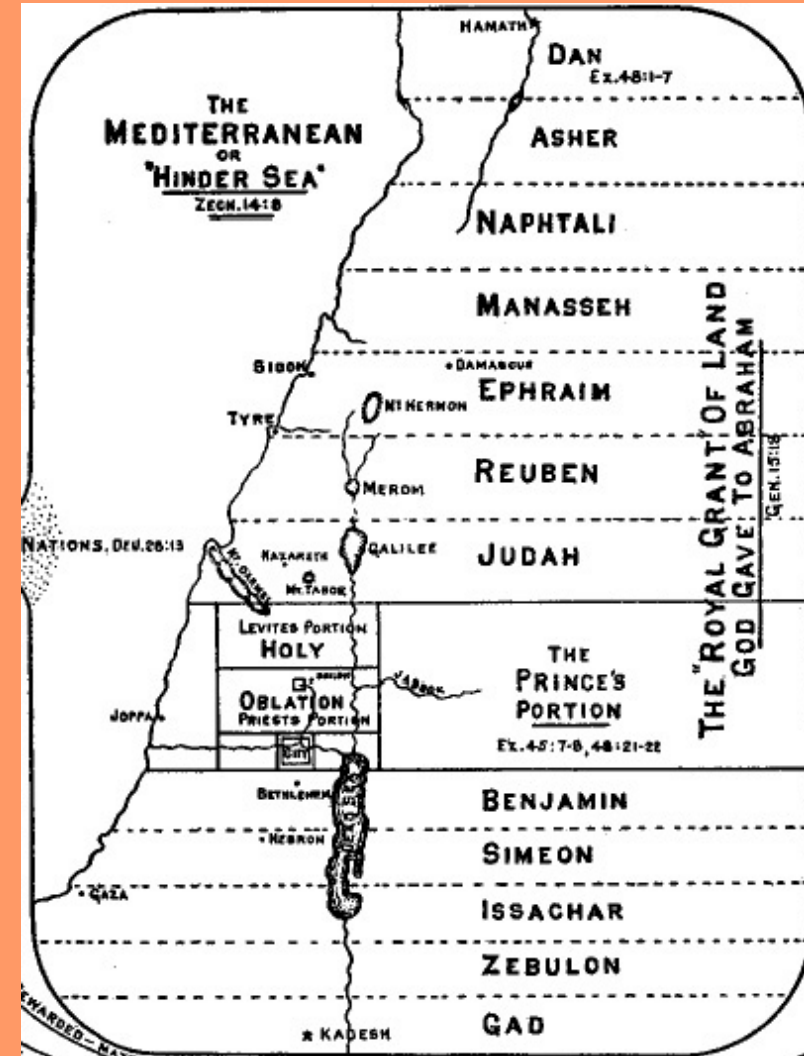
# Different, but similar, geography



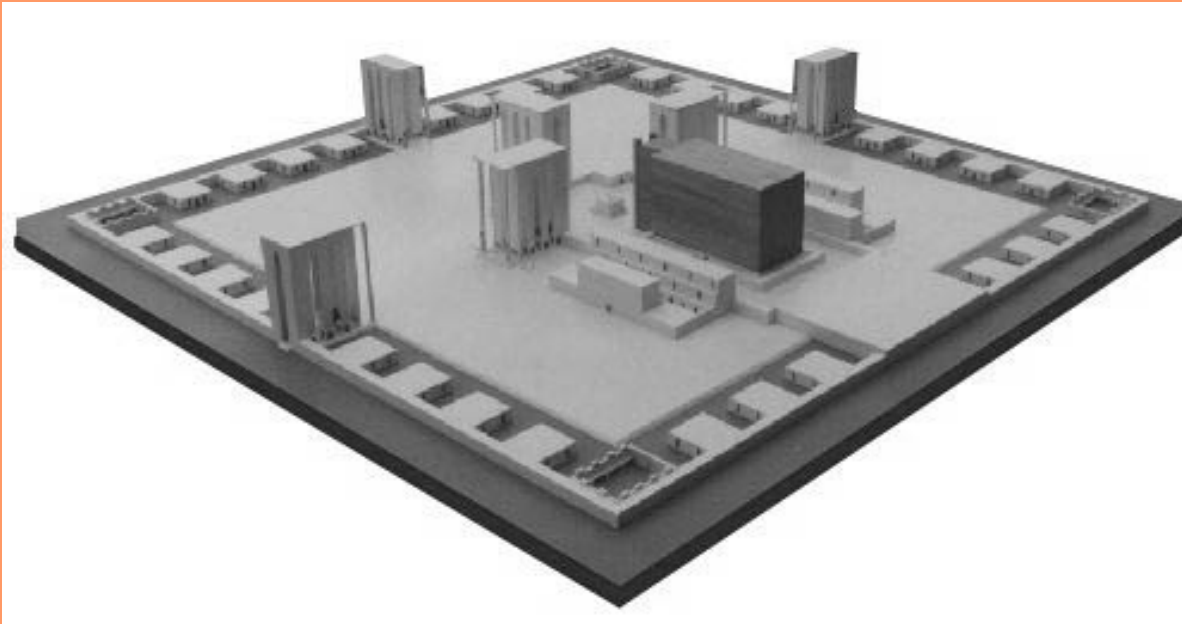
Zechariah 14:8-11 “<sup>8</sup>And it shall be in that day, that living waters shall go out from Jerusalem; half of them toward the former sea, and half of them toward the hinder sea: in summer and in winter shall it be. <sup>9</sup>And the LORD shall be king over all the earth: in that day shall there be one LORD, and his name one. <sup>10</sup>All the land shall be turned as a plain from Geba to Rimmon south of Jerusalem: and it shall be lifted up, and inhabited in her place, from Benjamin's gate to the place of the first gate, to the corner gate, and from the tower of Hananeel to the king's winepresses. <sup>11</sup>And men shall dwell in it, and there shall be no more utter destruction; but Jerusalem shall be safely inhabited.”

# New boundaries for Israel & tribes

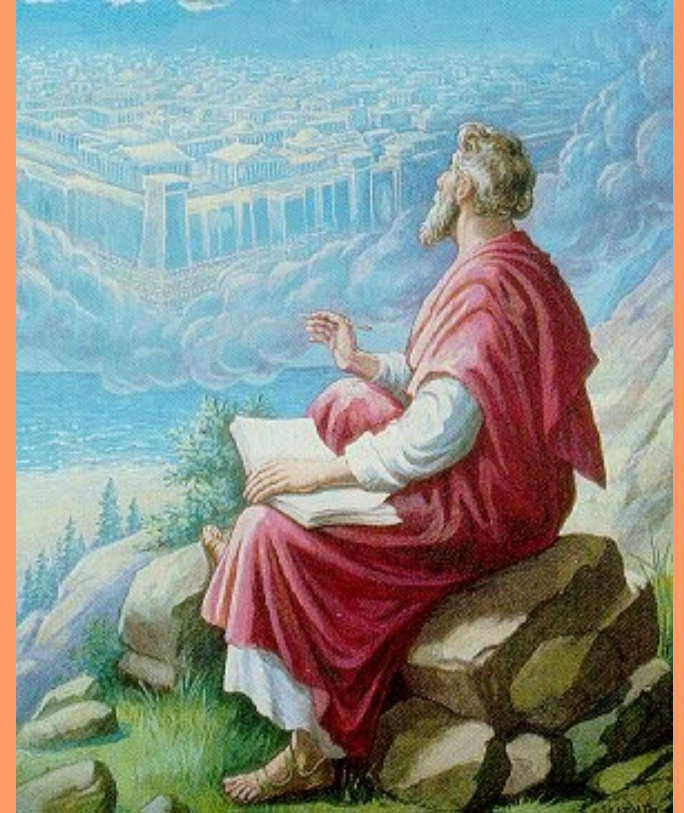
Ezekiel 47:13-23 “<sup>13</sup>Thus said the Lord GOD; This shall be the border, whereby you shall inherit the land according to the twelve tribes of Israel: Joseph shall have two portions. <sup>14</sup>And you shall inherit it, one as well as another: concerning the which I lifted up my hand to give it to your fathers: and this land shall fall to you for inheritance. <sup>15</sup>And this shall be the border of the land toward the north side, from the great sea, the way of Hethlon, as men go to Zedad; <sup>16</sup>Hamath, Berothah, Sibraim, which is between the border of Damascus and the border of Hamath; . . . <sup>21</sup>So shall you divide this land to you according to the tribes of Israel. <sup>22</sup>And it shall come to pass, that you shall divide it by lot for an inheritance to you, and to the strangers that sojourn among you, which shall beget children among you: and they shall be to you as born in the country among the children of Israel; they shall have inheritance with you among the tribes of Israel. <sup>23</sup>And it shall come to pass, that in what tribe the stranger sojourns, there shall you give him his inheritance, said the Lord GOD.”

# Apostles judge tribes at pearl gates

Matthew 19:28-30 “<sup>28</sup>And Jesus said to them, Truly I say to you, That you which have followed me, in the regeneration when the Son of man shall sit in the throne of his glory, you also shall sit on twelve thrones, judging the twelve tribes of Israel. <sup>29</sup>And every one that has forsaken houses, or brothers, or sisters, or father, or mother, or wife, or children, or lands, for my name's sake, shall receive an hundred times, and shall inherit everlasting life. <sup>30</sup>But many that are first shall be last; and the last shall be first.”

Revelation 21:18-21 “<sup>18</sup>And the building of the wall of it was of jasper: and the city was pure gold, like to clear glass. <sup>19</sup>And the foundations of the wall of the city were garnished with all manner of precious stones. The first foundation was jasper; the second, sapphire; the third, a chalcedony; the fourth, an emerald; <sup>20</sup>The fifth, sardonyx; the sixth, sardius; the seventh, chrysolite; the eighth, beryl; the ninth, a topaz; the tenth, a chrysoprasus; the eleventh, a jacinth; the twelfth, an amethyst. <sup>21</sup>And the twelve gates were twelve pearls: every several gate was of one pearl: and the street of the city was pure gold, as it were transparent glass.”

# King Jesus, son of David, reigns

Isaiah 9:6-7 “<sup>6</sup>For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given; and the government shall be upon his shoulder; and his name is called Wonderful, Counsellor, Mighty God, Father of Eternity, Prince of Peace. <sup>7</sup>Of the increase of his government and of peace there shall be no end, upon the throne of David and over his kingdom, to establish it, and to uphold it with judgment and with righteousness, from henceforth even for ever. The zeal of Jehovah of hosts will perform this.”



# King Jesus as the Great Shepherd

Ezekiel 34:22-31 “<sup>22</sup>Therefore will I save my flock, and they shall no more be a prey; and I will judge between cattle and cattle. <sup>23</sup>And I will set up one shepherd over them, and he shall feed them, even my servant David; he shall feed them, and he shall be their shepherd. <sup>24</sup>And I the LORD will be their God, and my servant David a prince among them; I the LORD have spoken it. <sup>25</sup>And I will make with them a covenant of peace, and will cause the evil beasts to cease out of the land: and they shall dwell safely in the wilderness, and sleep in the woods. <sup>26</sup>And I will make them and the places round about my hill a blessing; and I will cause the shower to come down in his season; there shall be showers of blessing. <sup>27</sup>And the tree of the field shall yield her fruit, and the earth shall yield her increase, and they shall be safe in their land, and shall know that I am the LORD, when I have broken the bands of their yoke, and delivered them out of the hand of those that served themselves of them. <sup>28</sup>And they shall no more be a prey to the heathen, neither shall the beast of the land devour them; but they shall dwell safely, and none shall make them afraid. <sup>29</sup>And I will raise up for them a plant of renown, and they shall be no more consumed with hunger in the land, neither bear the shame of the heathen any more. <sup>30</sup>Thus shall they know that I the LORD their God am with them, and that they, even the house of Israel, are my people, said the Lord GOD. <sup>31</sup>And you my flock, the flock of my pasture, are men, and I am your God, said the Lord GOD.”

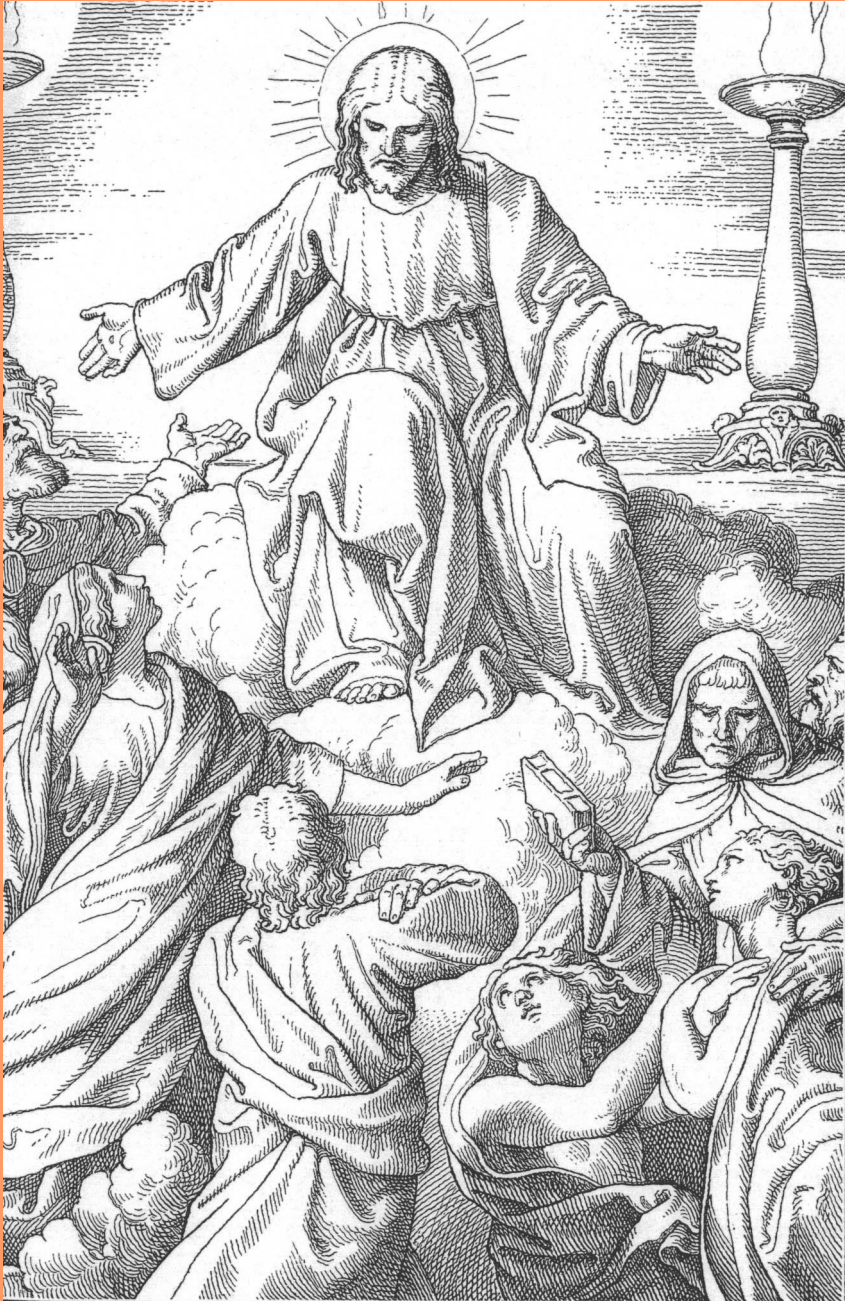


# Animals exhibit Edenic tameness



Isaiah 11:6-9 “<sup>6</sup>The wolf also shall dwell with the lamb, and the leopard shall lie down with the kid; and the calf and the young lion and the fatted calf together; and a little child shall lead them. <sup>7</sup>And the cow and the bear shall feed; their young ones shall lie down together: and the lion shall eat straw like the ox. <sup>8</sup>And the sucking child shall play on the hole of the asp, and the weaned child shall put his hand on the cockatrice' den. <sup>9</sup>They shall not hurt nor destroy in all my holy mountain: for the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the LORD, as the waters cover the sea.”

# Jesus judges with righteousness



Isaiah 11:1-5 “<sup>1</sup>And there shall come forth a rod out of the stem of Jesse, and a Branch shall grow out of his roots: <sup>2</sup>And the spirit of the LORD shall rest on him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD; <sup>3</sup>And shall make him of quick understanding in the fear of the LORD: and he shall not judge after the sight of his eyes, neither reprove after the hearing of his ears: <sup>4</sup>But with righteousness shall he judge the poor, and reprove with equity for the meek of the earth: and he shall smite the earth: with the rod of his mouth, and with the breath of his lips shall he slay the wicked. <sup>5</sup>And righteousness shall be the girdle of his loins, and faithfulness the girdle of his reins.”

# Water of life & Tree of life

Revelation 22:1-9 “<sup>1</sup>And he showed me a pure river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding out of the throne of God and of the Lamb. <sup>2</sup>In the middle of the street of it, and on either side of the river, was there the tree of life, which bore twelve manner of fruits, and yielded her fruit every month: and the leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations.

<sup>3</sup>And there shall be no more curse: but the throne of God and of the Lamb shall be in it; and his servants shall serve him: <sup>4</sup>And they shall see his face; and his name shall be in their foreheads. <sup>5</sup>And there shall be no night there; and they need no candle, neither light of the sun; for the Lord God gives them light: and they shall reign for ever and ever. <sup>6</sup>And he said to me, These sayings are faithful and true: and the Lord God of the holy prophets sent his angel to show to his servants the things which must shortly be done. <sup>7</sup>Behold, I come quickly: blessed is he that keeps the sayings of the prophecy of this book. <sup>8</sup>And I John saw these things, and heard them. And when I had heard and seen, I fell down to worship before the feet of the angel which showed me these things. <sup>9</sup>Then said he to me, See you do it not: for I am your fellow servant, and of your brothers the prophets, and of them which keep the sayings of this book: worship God.”



# New choice: water of life or lake of fire

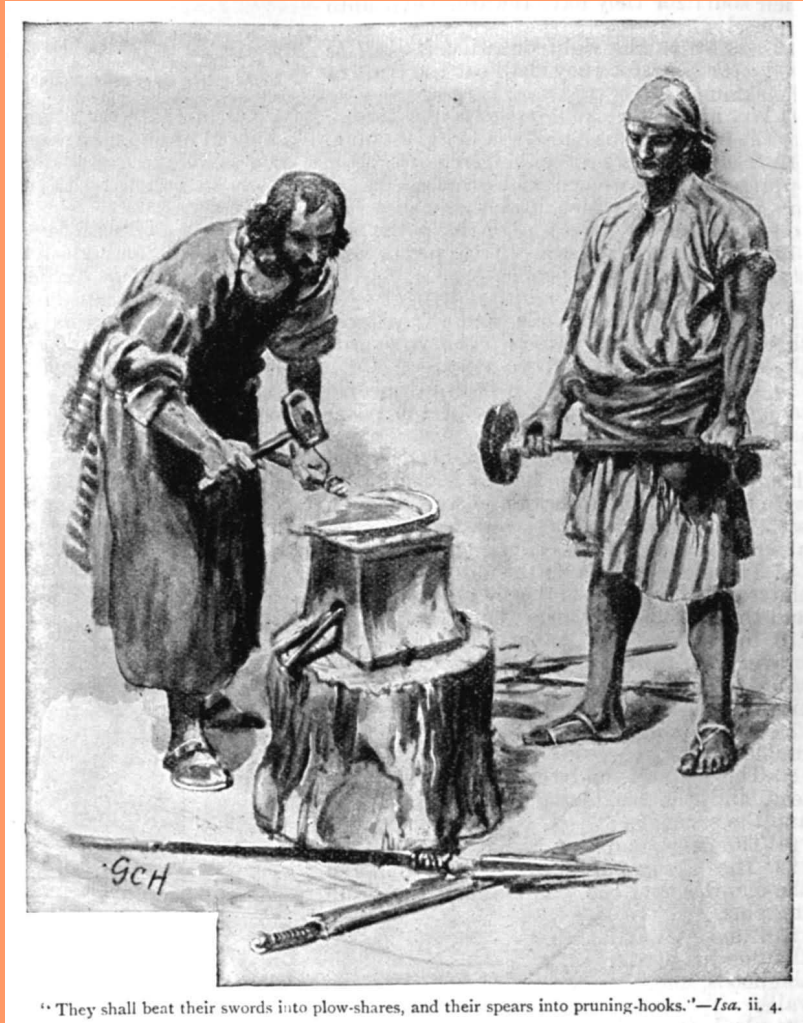
Revelation 21:5-8 “<sup>5</sup>And he that sat on the throne said, Behold, I make all things new. And he said to me, Write: for these words are true and faithful. <sup>6</sup>And he said to me, It is done. I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end. I will give to him that is thirsty of the fountain of the water of life freely. <sup>7</sup>He that overcomes shall inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be my son. <sup>8</sup>But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and fornicators, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burns with fire and brimstone: which is the second death.”



Revelation 22:16-17 “<sup>16</sup>I Jesus have sent my angel to testify to you these things in the churches. I am the root and the offspring of David, and the bright and morning star. <sup>17</sup>And the Spirit and the bride say, Come. And let him that hears say, Come. And let him that is thirsty come. And whoever will, let him take the water of life freely.”

# No longer learn war

Isaiah 2:2-5 “<sup>2</sup>And it shall come to pass in the last days, that the mountain of the LORD's house shall be established in the top of the mountains, and shall be exalted above the hills; and all nations shall flow to it. <sup>3</sup>And many people shall go and say, Come you, and let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, to the house of the God of Jacob; and he will teach us of his ways, and we will walk in his paths: for out of Zion shall go forth the law, and the word of the LORD from Jerusalem. <sup>4</sup>And he shall judge among the nations, and shall rebuke many people: and they shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruning hooks: nation shall not lift up sword against nation, neither shall they learn war any more. <sup>5</sup>O house of Jacob, come you, and let us walk in the light of the LORD.”

# Now we faithfully run cities

Luke 19:12-19 “<sup>12</sup>He said therefore, A certain nobleman went into a far country to receive for himself a kingdom, and to return. <sup>13</sup>And he called his ten servants, and delivered them ten pounds, and said to them, Occupy till I come. <sup>14</sup>But his citizens hated him, and sent a message after him, saying, We will not have this man to reign over us. <sup>15</sup>And it came to pass, that when he was returned, having received the kingdom, then he commanded these servants to be called to him, to whom he had given the money, that he might know how much every man had gained by trading. <sup>16</sup>Then came the first, saying, Lord, your pound has gained ten pounds. <sup>17</sup>And he said to him, Well, you good servant: because you have been faithful in a very little, have you authority over ten cities. <sup>18</sup>And the second came, saying, Lord, your pound has gained five pounds. <sup>19</sup>And he said likewise to him, Be you also over five cities.”



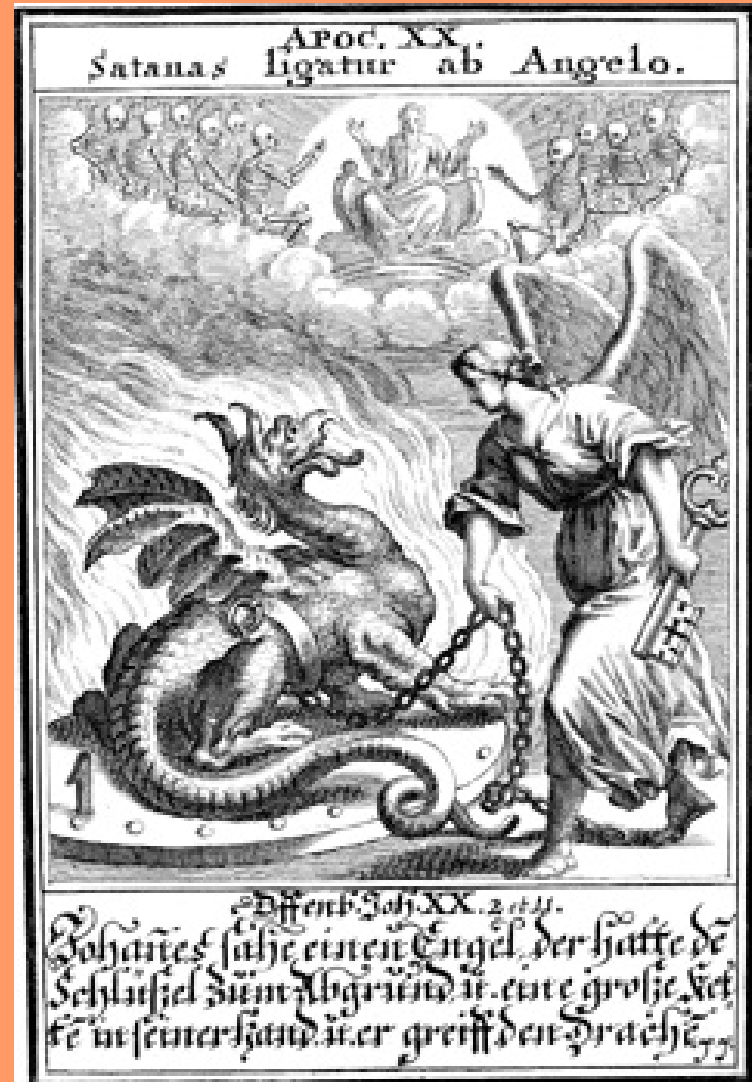
# Jesus will punish nations in Millennium

Zechariah 14:12-19 “<sup>16</sup>And it shall come to pass, that every one that is left of all the nations which came against Jerusalem shall even go up from year to year to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, and to keep the feast of tabernacles. <sup>17</sup>And it shall be, that whoever will not come up of all the families of the earth to Jerusalem to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, even on them shall be no rain. <sup>18</sup>And if the family of Egypt go not up, and come not, that have no rain; there shall be the plague, with which the LORD will smite the heathen that come not up to keep the feast of tabernacles. <sup>19</sup>This shall be the punishment of Egypt, and the punishment of all nations that come not up to keep the feast of tabernacles.”

Psalms 2:6-9 “<sup>6</sup>Yet have I set my king on my holy hill of Zion. <sup>7</sup>I will declare the decree: the LORD has said to me, You are my Son; this day have I begotten you. <sup>8</sup>Ask of me, and I shall give you the heathen for your inheritance, and the uttermost parts of the earth for your possession. <sup>9</sup>You shall break them with a rod of iron; you shall dash them in pieces like a potter's vessel.”

# Satan loosed at end of 1,000 years

Revelation 20:1-3 “<sup>1</sup>And I saw an angel come down from heaven, having the key of the bottomless pit and a great chain in his hand. <sup>2</sup>And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the Devil, and Satan, and bound him a thousand years, <sup>3</sup>And cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal on him, that he should deceive the nations no more, till the thousand years should be fulfilled: and after that he must be loosed a little season.”



# Wicked devoured; Satan cast into fire

Revelation 20:7-15 “<sup>7</sup>And when the thousand years are expired, Satan shall be loosed out of his prison, <sup>8</sup>And shall go out to deceive the nations which are in the four quarters of the earth, Gog, and Magog, to gather them together to battle: the number of whom is as the sand of the sea. <sup>9</sup>And they went up on the breadth of the earth, and compassed the camp of the saints about, and the beloved city: and fire came down from God out of heaven, and devoured them. <sup>10</sup>And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever.”



# Jesus will judge based on compassion to Jews at the end of the millennium

Matthew 25:31-40 “<sup>31</sup>When the Son of man shall come in his glory, and all the holy angels with him, then shall he sit on the throne of his glory: <sup>32</sup>And before him shall be gathered all nations: and he shall separate them one from another, as a shepherd divides his sheep from the goats: <sup>33</sup>And he shall set the sheep on his right hand, but the goats on the left. <sup>34</sup>Then shall the King say to them on his right hand, Come, you blessed of my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world: <sup>35</sup>For I was an hungered, and you gave me meat: I was thirsty, and you gave me drink: I was a stranger, and you took me in: <sup>36</sup>Naked, and you clothed me: I was sick, and you visited me: I was in prison, and you came to me. <sup>37</sup>Then shall the righteous answer him, saying, Lord, when saw we you an hungered, and fed you? or thirsty, and gave you drink? <sup>38</sup>When saw we you a stranger, and took you in? or naked, and clothed you? <sup>39</sup>Or when saw we you sick, or in prison, and came to you? <sup>40</sup>And the King shall answer and say to them, Truly I say to you, Inasmuch as you have done it to one of the least of these my brothers, you have done it to me.”



# Everlasting fire and punishment

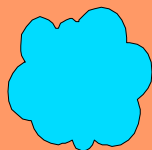
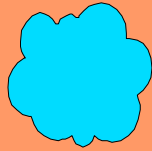

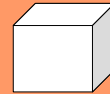
Rosh Hashanah is celebrated two days and considered one long day. When Christ comes He will keep it bright:

Zechariah 14:6-7 "<sup>6</sup>And it shall come to pass in **that day**, that the light shall not be clear, nor dark: <sup>7</sup>But it shall be one day which shall be known to the LORD, not day, nor night: but it shall come to pass, that at evening time it shall be light."

## New Jerusalem



Revelation 21:9-17 “<sup>9</sup>And there came to me one of the seven angels which had the seven vials full of the seven last plagues, and talked with me, saying, Come here, I will show you the bride, the Lamb's wife. <sup>10</sup>And he carried me away in the spirit to a great and high mountain, and showed me that great city, the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God, <sup>11</sup>Having the glory of God: and her light was like to a stone most precious, even like a jasper stone, clear as crystal; <sup>12</sup>And had a wall great and high, and had twelve gates, and at the gates twelve angels, and names written thereon, which are the names of the twelve tribes of the children of Israel: <sup>13</sup>On the east three gates; on the north three gates; on the south three gates; and on the west three gates. <sup>14</sup>And the wall of the city had twelve foundations, and in them the names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb. <sup>15</sup>And he that talked with me had a golden reed to measure the city, and the gates thereof, and the wall thereof. <sup>16</sup>And the city lies foursquare, and the length is as large as the breadth: and he measured the city with the reed, twelve thousand furlongs. While the Bride is safe in New Jerusalem and the earth is destroyed by fire, during the wedding feast of 7 days, Jesus will reward his servants.

God chose to dwell in a cubical called the Holy of Holies on earth (1 Kings 6:20), so His Bride will now dwell in holiness with Him. The base of the New Jerusalem would have been equal to 144 million square stadia. A furlong or stadia is about 600 feet, thus the area of the base (and each face of the cube) is 1500 miles by 1500 miles. If resting on the Earth, its ceiling would be inside our current exosphere (the last layer before space), and its base would cut a trench in the earth up to 70 feet deep near its center. There would be plenty of space for every believer in Yahweh since creation.

Since a third of the day and night are gone, it may act as an additional luminary in the sky.

## Jesus comes to reward His servants

Revelation 11:15-18 “<sup>15</sup>And the seventh angel sounded; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord, and of his Christ; and he shall reign for ever and ever. <sup>16</sup>And the four and twenty elders, which sat before God on their seats, fell on their faces, and worshipped God, <sup>17</sup>Saying, We give you thanks, O LORD God Almighty, which are, and were, and are to come; because you have taken to you your great power, and have reigned. <sup>18</sup>And the nations were angry, **and your wrath is come**, and the time of the **dead**, that they should be **judged**, and that you should **give reward to your servants** the prophets, and to the saints, and them that fear your name, small and great; **and should destroy them which destroy the earth.**”

Reward is *misthos* in Greek, meaning pay for service, whether good or bad. It is the final outcome for your life's work.

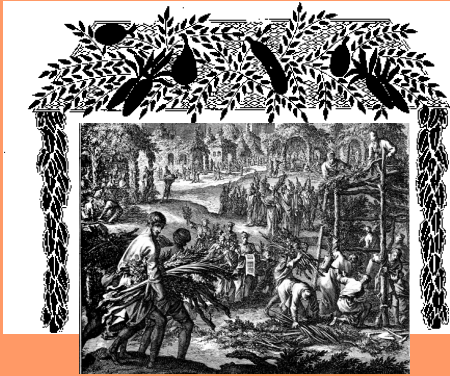

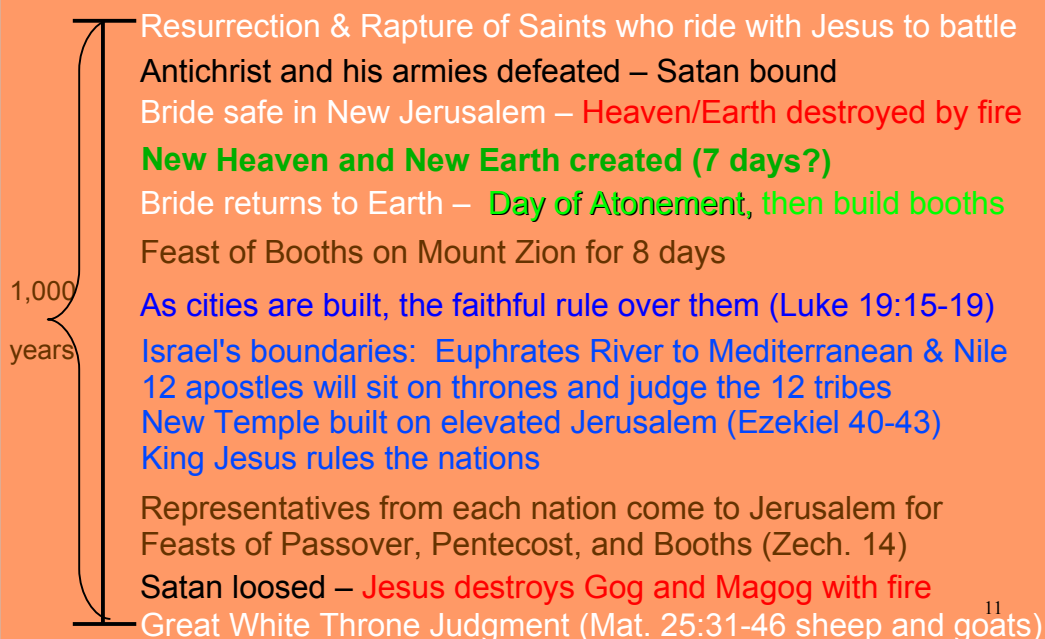
## Feast of Booths on Mount Zion

Israel's boundaries in Ezekiel 47-48.

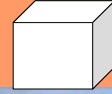
Land of Judah made a plain while Jerusalem remains elevated (Zech 14:10)

I correlate the parable of separating the sheep and goats to the Great White Throne Judgment because it is based upon works, not faith. These people lived through the 1,000 years with King Jesus physically reigning, yet did not live according to His ways of mercy, and are judged according to their lack of compassion on those less fortunate.

Zechariah 14:16-19 “<sup>16</sup>And it shall come to pass, that every one that is left of all the nations which came against Jerusalem shall even go up from year to year to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, and to keep the feast of tabernacles. <sup>17</sup>And it shall be, that whoever will not come up of all the families of the earth to Jerusalem to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, even on them shall be no rain. <sup>18</sup>And if the family of Egypt go not up, and come not, that have no rain; there shall be the plague, with which the LORD will smite the heathen that come not up to keep the feast of tabernacles. <sup>19</sup>This shall be the punishment of Egypt, and the punishment of all nations that come not up to keep the feast of tabernacles.”

## New Jerusalem is a new 'moon'

Revelation 21:22-27 “22And I saw no temple therein: for the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are the temple of it. 23And the city had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it: for the glory of God did lighten it, and the Lamb is the light thereof. 24And the nations of them which are saved shall walk in the light of it: and the kings of the earth do bring their glory and honor into it. 25And the gates of it shall not be shut at all by day: for there shall be no night there. 26And they shall bring the glory and honor of the nations into it. 27And there shall in no wise enter into it any thing that defiles, neither whatever works abomination, or makes a lie: but they which are written in the Lamb's book of life. ”

The New Jerusalem has a volume of **3.375 billion cubic miles**, which is about half the volume of the moon. It does not reflect light, but emanates light from within.

John says it comes down out of heaven, but he doesn't say it lands or rests upon the earth. Since its base would take up half or more of any continent, and greatly depress the earth's crust, and the nations walk by its light, it sounds much more like a moon. It's presence at Christ's 2<sup>nd</sup> coming allows Rosh Hashanah to have light for more than 24 hours.

Jesus may give people a choice to remain in New Jerusalem and live like the angels (no sex) or to return to earth to rebuild and repopulate the earth. Or it may only be those who were alive at His coming who are then returned to earth to live there.



## Long life with children on new earth

Isaiah 65:17-25 "17For, behold, I create new heavens and a new earth: and the former shall not be remembered, nor come into mind. 18But be you glad and rejoice for ever in that which I create: for, behold, I create Jerusalem a rejoicing, and her people a joy. 19And I will rejoice in Jerusalem, and joy in my people: and the voice of weeping shall be no more heard in her, nor the voice of crying. 20There shall be no more there an infant of days, nor an old man that has not filled his days: for the child shall die an hundred years old; but the sinner being an hundred years old shall be accursed. 21And they shall build houses, and inhabit them; and they shall plant vineyards, and eat the fruit of them. 22They shall not build, and another inhabit; they shall not plant, and another eat: for as the days of a tree are the days of my people, and my elect shall long enjoy the work of their hands. 23They shall not labor in vain, nor bring forth for trouble; for they are the seed of the blessed of the LORD, and their offspring with them. 24And it shall come to pass, that before they call, I will answer; and while they are yet speaking, I will hear. 25The wolf and the lamb shall feed together, and the lion shall eat straw like the bullock; and dust shall be the serpent's meat. They shall not hurt nor destroy in all my holy mountain, said the LORD."

Heaven is not a place to satisfy earthly desires. Those souls in heaven don't have sex, but I think those resurrected and living on earth do marry and have sex and raise children.

Isaiah 59:21 "21As for me, this is my covenant with them, said the LORD; My spirit that is on you, and my words which I have put in your mouth, shall not depart out of your mouth, nor out of the mouth of your seed, nor out of the mouth of your seed's seed, said the LORD, from now on and for ever."

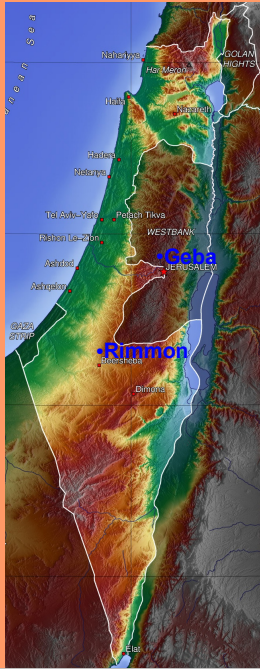
## We reign with Christ 1,000 years



Revelation 20:4-6 “<sup>4</sup>And I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and judgment was given to them: and I saw the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received his mark on their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years. <sup>5</sup>But the rest of the dead lived not again until the thousand years were finished. This is the first resurrection. <sup>6</sup>Blessed and holy is he that has part in the first resurrection: on such the second death has no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with him a thousand years.” <sup>14</sup>

During this time, “<sup>20</sup>There shall be no more there an infant of days, nor an old man that has not filled his days: for the child shall die an hundred years old; but the sinner being an hundred years old shall be accursed.” (Isaiah 65:20) Yes, sadly some people will choose to sin during the reign of King Jesus on earth.

## Different, but similar, geography



Zechariah 14:8-11 “<sup>8</sup>And it shall be in that day, that living waters shall go out from Jerusalem; half of them toward the former sea, and half of them toward the hinder sea: in summer and in winter shall it be. <sup>9</sup>And the LORD shall be king over all the earth: in that day shall there be one LORD, and his name one. <sup>10</sup>All the land shall be turned as a plain from Geba to Rimmon south of Jerusalem: and it shall be lifted up, and inhabited in her place, from Benjamin's gate to the place of the first gate, to the corner gate, and from the tower of Hananeel to the king's winepresses. <sup>11</sup>And men shall dwell in it, and there shall be no more utter destruction; but Jerusalem shall be safely inhabited.”<sup>15</sup>

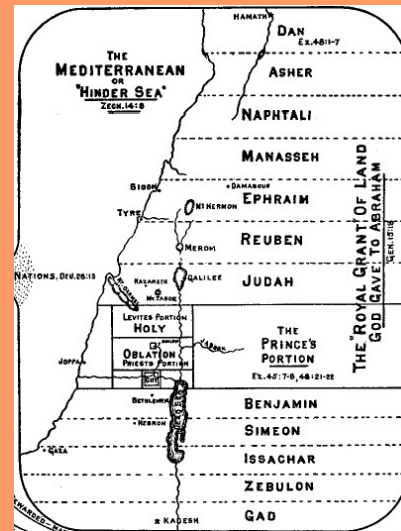
Recall Rev. 6:12-14(edited) “when he had opened the sixth seal, there was a great earthquake; and every mountain and island were moved out of their places.”

After Noah's flood, the Euphrates River was still recognizable, and I think the seas and major rivers will be recognizable on the new earth as well.

Geba is Al Geba, 6 miles north of Jerusalem.\* Rimmon is located 5 mile north of Beer-sheba,\* there being about 50 miles between the two cities allocated to Judah. [Rimmon may be Ain-Rimmon in Joshua 15:19-20, 32 “<sup>19</sup>Who answered, Give me a blessing; for you have given me a south land; give me also springs of water. And he gave her the upper springs, and the nether springs. <sup>20</sup>This is the inheritance of the tribe of the children of Judah according to their families. <sup>21</sup>And the uttermost cities of the tribe of the children of Judah toward the coast of Edom southward were Kabzeel, and Eder, and Jagur, <sup>32</sup>And Lebaoth, and Shilhim, and Ain, and Rimmon: all the cities are twenty and nine, with their villages:”]

## New boundaries for Israel & tribes

Ezekiel 47:13-23 “<sup>13</sup>Thus said the Lord GOD; This shall be the border, whereby you shall inherit the land according to the twelve tribes of Israel: Joseph shall have two portions. <sup>14</sup>And you shall inherit it, one as well as another: concerning the which I lifted up my hand to give it to your fathers: and this land shall fall to you for inheritance. <sup>15</sup>And this shall be the border of the land toward the north side, from the great sea, the way of Hethlon, as men go to Zedad; <sup>16</sup>Hamath, Berothah, Sibram, which is between the border of Damascus and the border of Hamath; . . . <sup>21</sup>So shall you divide this land to you according to the tribes of Israel. <sup>22</sup>And it shall come to pass, that you shall divide it by lot for an inheritance to you, and to the strangers that sojourn among you, which shall beget children among you: and they shall be to you as born in the country among the children of Israel; they shall have inheritance with you among the tribes of Israel. <sup>23</sup>And it shall come to pass, that in what tribe the stranger sojourns, there shall you give him his inheritance, said the Lord GOD.”



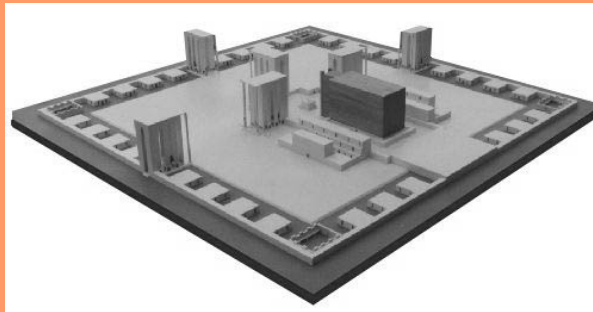

The drawing of Israel's tribal boundaries during the millennium is by Clarence Larkin based upon God's covenant with Abraham in Genesis 15:18 “<sup>18</sup>In the same day the LORD made a covenant with Abram, saying, To your seed have I given this land, from the river of Egypt to the great river, the river Euphrates:” and Ezekiel's prophecies. Ezekiel 45:1-8 contains the boundaries of the holy portion and the prince's portion. The description of borders for the twelve tribes begins in Ezekiel 47 and ends in 48.

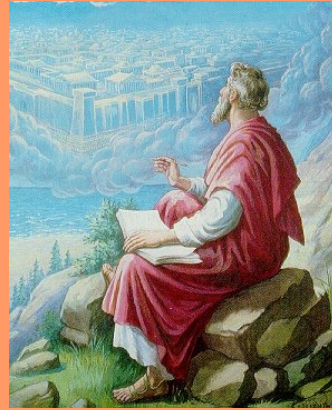
We know there were 144,000 Jews sealed prior to Christ's return, and a Jewish remnant of at least 100,000 more saved in Petra. So there is a good Jewish population with which to start the new country of Israel.

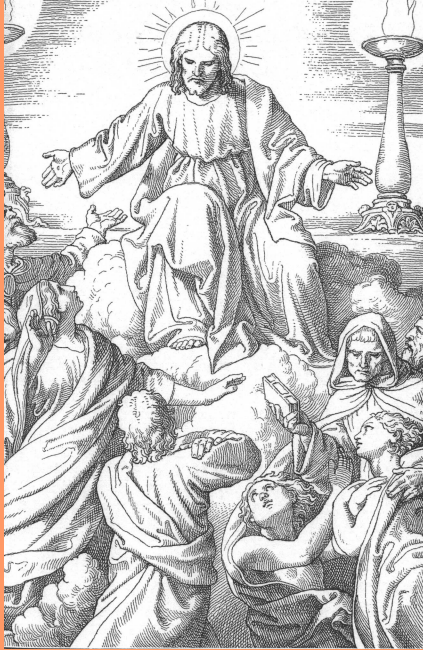

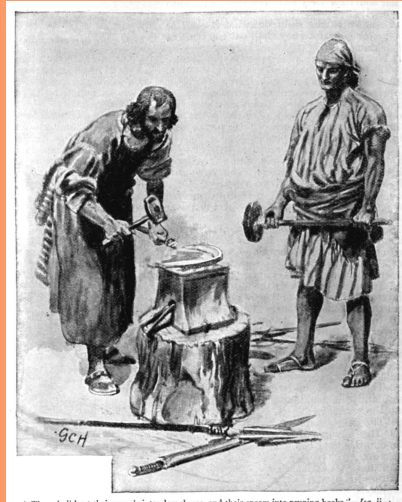

Revelation 20:7-15 "7And when the thousand years are expired, Satan shall be loosed out of his prison, 8And shall go out to deceive the nations which are in the four quarters of the earth, **Gog, and Magog**, to gather them together to battle: the number of whom is as the sand of the sea. 9And they went up on the breadth of the earth, and compassed the camp of the saints about, and the beloved city: and fire came down from God out of heaven, and devoured them. 10And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever."

This is the final attempt of Gog and Magog to destroy Jerusalem and Israel, but they will be destroyed by fire. Their first attempt (Ezekiel 38-39) was defeated by the Macabbees 100 years before Christ was born. The battle of Armegeddon in Rev. 16:12-16 after the 6<sup>th</sup> vial does not mention Gog or Magog, but the whole world.

## Jesus will judge based on compassion to Jews at the end of the millennium

Matthew 25:31-40 “<sup>31</sup>When the Son of man shall come in his glory, and all the holy angels with him, then shall he sit on the throne of his glory: <sup>32</sup>And before him shall be gathered all nations: and he shall separate them one from another, as a shepherd divides his sheep from the goats: <sup>33</sup>And he shall set the sheep on his right hand, but the goats on the left. <sup>34</sup>Then shall the King say to them on his right hand, Come, you blessed of my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world: <sup>35</sup>For I was an hungered, and you gave me meat: I was thirsty, and you gave me drink: I was a stranger, and you took me in: <sup>36</sup>Naked, and you clothed me: I was sick, and you visited me: I was in prison, and you came to me. <sup>37</sup>Then shall the righteous answer him, saying, Lord, when saw we you an hungered, and fed you? or thirsty, and gave you drink? <sup>38</sup>When saw we you a stranger, and took you in? or naked, and clothed you? <sup>39</sup>Or when saw we you sick, or in prison, and came to you? <sup>40</sup>And the King shall answer and say to them, Truly I say to you, Inasmuch as you have done it to one of the least of these my brothers, you have done it to me.” 30

Since these people refused to believe in Jesus, He will judge them according to how they treated Jews.

## Everlasting fire and punishment

Matthew 25:41-45 “<sup>41</sup>Then shall he say also to them on the left hand, Depart from me, you cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels: <sup>42</sup>For I was an hungered, and you gave me no meat: I was thirsty, and you gave me no drink: <sup>43</sup>I was a stranger, and you took me not in: naked, and you clothed me not: sick, and in prison, and you visited me not. <sup>44</sup>Then shall they also answer him, saying, Lord, when saw we you an hungered, or thirsty, or a stranger, or naked, or sick, or in prison, and did not minister to you? <sup>45</sup>Then shall he answer them, saying, Truly I say to you, Inasmuch as you did it not to one of the least of these, you did it not to me. <sup>46</sup>And these shall go away into everlasting punishment: but the righteous into life eternal.”

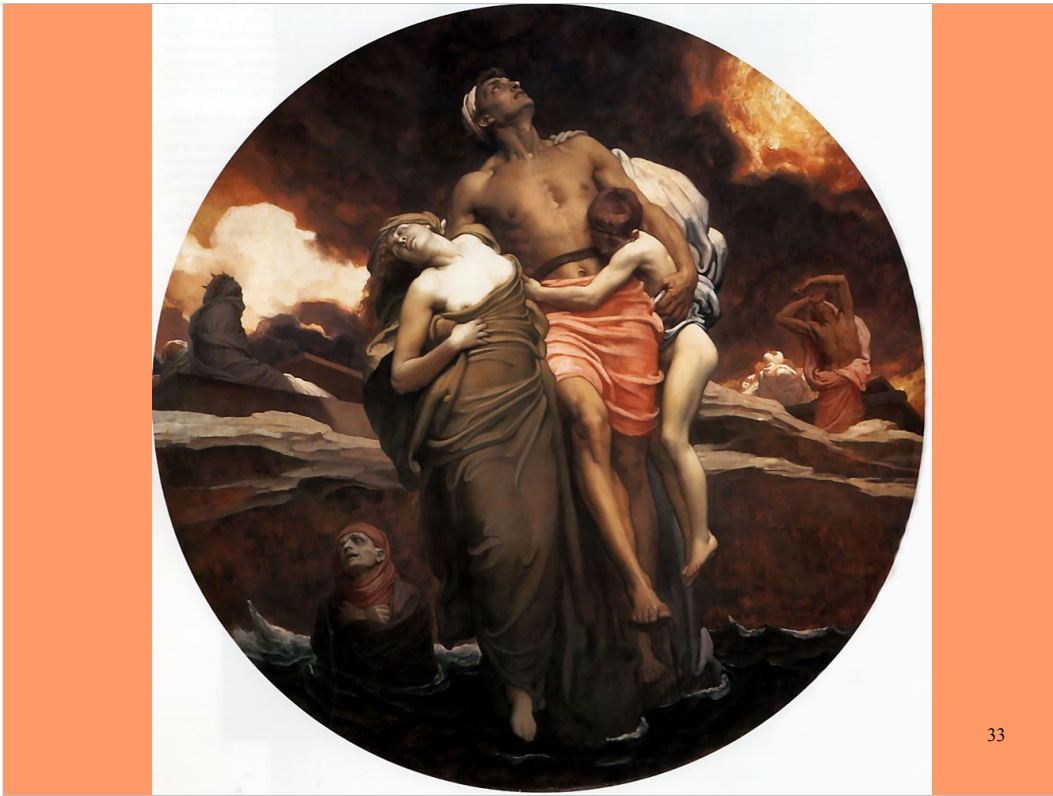

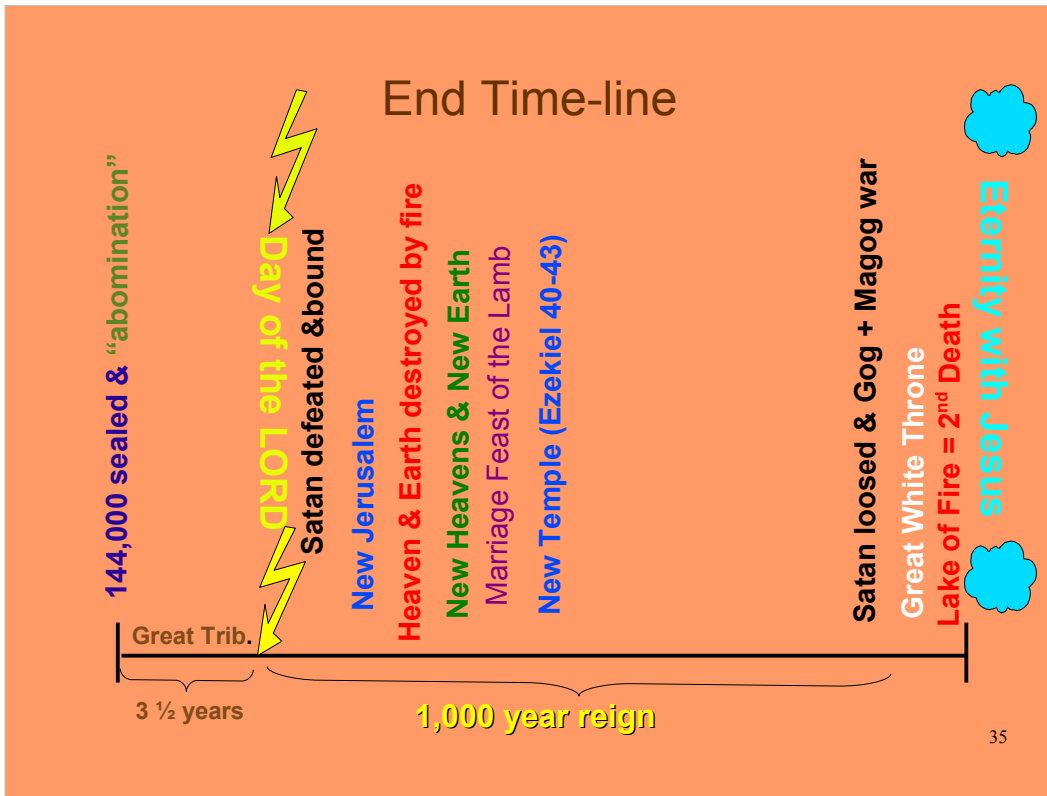
