




Fertile Crescent

Total number of days is 14,610 days which = 365.25 days x 40 years
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2,190 = 6 years of 5(360) + 1(390)

2,190 = 6 years

+1,470 = 4 years of 3(360) + 1(390)
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14,610 = 40 years

So multiples of 40 years in Biblical prophecy will align with our 365.25 day calendars.



From Jacob's move to Egypt until the Exodus was 215 years.

It was only about the last 100 years of their time in Egypt that the Hebrews were enslaved and afflicted.

Mesopotamia & Egypt worship Sin, the moon-god, represented by bull





Found by Woolley in temple ruins near Ur

Called Nanna by the Sumerians, Sin, the moon-god, was originally a man who had a beard made of lapis lazuli and rode on a winged bull. His symbols are the crescent moon, the bull, and a tripod (like a lamp-stand).

Though this Apis bull votive offering has a sun disc on its head. A prospective new Apis bull was required to have **a white crescent** on one side of its body or a white triangle on its forehead, signifying its unique character and its acceptance by the moon-god.

"The Old Testament constantly rebuked the worship of the Moon-god (see: Deut. 4:19;17:3; II Kngs. 21:3,5; 23:5; Jer. 8:2; 19:13; Zeph. 1:5, etc.) When Israel fell into idolatry, it was usually the cult of the Moon-god. Everywhere in the ancient world, the symbol of the crescent moon can be found on seal impressions, steles, pottery, amulets, clay tablets, cylinders, weights, earrings, necklaces, wall murals, etc. In Tel-el-Obeid (ruins of tower of Babel), a copper calf was found with a crescent moon on its forehead. An idol with the body of a bull and the head of man has a crescent moon inlaid on its forehead with shells. In Ur, the Stela of Ur-Nammu has the crescent symbol placed at the top of the register of gods because the Moon-god was the head of the gods. Even bread was baked in the form of a crescent as an act of devotion to the Moon-god. The Ur of the Chaldees was so devoted to the Moon-god that it was sometimes called Nannar in tablets from that time period." [http://www.yeshua.co.uk]


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

Yup, the fertile crescent.




Secular historians have the Hittites up north, whereas Biblical historians locate them south of Israel.

Though the names are spread out, each of these people groups are either in or next to Israel's current borders. These are the ten peoples Abraham's seed was to disposess.



The Fertile Crescent had to be conquered by every empire because it contains the travel routes between Africa and Asia and the East.

The Four Empires of Daniel 2 all included these ancient Assyrian lands. Today the people who still occupy a great deal of the ancient Assyrian lands are called KURDS, and they would like to restore their own identity from Lebanon, Syria, Turkey, **Iraq** and Iran.



All the ancient calendars were composed of 360 day years, and then were adjusted by adding days or months intermittently. Twelve months of 30 days each is apparent in Noah's account that the waters abated after 5 months = 150 days.

Prior to the metatonic cycle developed by Hillel in 3rd century, it is believed the Hebrews used a 40-year cycle. Kings Saul, David, and Solomon each reigned for 40 years.

By dividing the 40 year cycle by 6 we get 6 remainder 4, and you can see how the pattern is similar to the 6 days or work and one of rest which God gave the Hebrews.

The groups of 6 years contain 5 years of 12 thirty-day months plus one year of 13 thirty-day months.

The group of 4 years contain 3 years of 12 thirty-day months plus one year of 13 thirty-day months.

So when dealing with prophecies, you can be assured that every multiple of 40 years is in agreement with a 365 day calendar.

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

2 years after God calls Abram, he and his family go to Egypt because of a famine, and return to Canaan 2 years later.

400 years is a multiple of 40, and would coincided with our years.

Jacob wrestled with the Angel of the LORD who changed his name from Jacob (deceiver) to Israel (prevail or prince of God).

Jacob has 12 sons who become the founders of the 12 tribes of Israel after their time in Egypt.



The Exodus coincides with Passover, and the giving of the Law on Mount Sinai coincides with Pentecost (Feast of Weeks).

Though it was only an eleven day trip to from Mount Horeb (Sinai) to Kadesh-barnea in Canaan, God took them a different route so that they would not immediately have to go to battle. (Deut. 1:2) But their fear and disobedience cost them forty years in the desert.

They resorted to worship of the moon-god bull so popular in Egypt The true God who created the moon had brought them out of bondage with mighty miracles.

Then Moses died and Joshua took them into the Promised Land of Canaan to destroy the idol worshippers there.

I'll explain the difference between the kingdoms of Israel and Judah on the next slide.



Southern 2 tribes are Judah and Benjamin, but Benjamin being so small, is usually referred to as Judah.* The northern tribes are known as the house of Israel.

It is under the reign of Ahaz that the people of the southern tribes are first called Jews.

2 Kings 16:6 "6At that time Rezin king of Syria recovered Elath to Syria, and drove the Jews from Elath: and the Syrians came to Elath, and dwelled there to this day."

The first chapter of how Babylon conquered Jerusalem in 605 and began deporting Jews is written in Hebrew, but then chapters 2-7 are written in Aramaic (the business language of the Babylonian Empire), and chapters 8-12 are written in Hebrew.

I believe chapters 2-7 were written in the language of the Gentiles because they deal specifically with the timeline of the Gentiles, and chapters 8-12 deal specifically with Israel.

We'll let Daniel describe Israel's future from here, which is mostly Israel's past now.



- 8:Gabriel tells Daniel the ram is Media/Persia, and the goat is Greece. When Alexander the Great died, his empire was divided among his four captains, one of whom rules Syria from which a "little horn" comes.
- 11:Syria is the kingdom of the north, and Egypt is the kingdom of the south. In this chapter Daniel describes the reigns of Antiochus IV (Syria) and Ptolemy VI (Egypt).



Daniel 8 prophesies the Medes/Persians (Ram) will conquer next

Daniel 5 describes the actual takeover with "the writing on the wall".

Cyrus, the Persian king foretold

Isaiah 45:1-6 "1Thus said the LORD to his anointed, to Cyrus, whose right hand I have held, to subdue nations before him; . . . that you may know that I, the LORD, which call you by your name, am the God of Israel. 4For Jacob my servant's sake, and Israel my elect, I have even called you by your name: I have surnamed you, though you have not known me. 5I am the LORD, and there is none else, there is no God beside me: I girded you, though you have not known me: 6That they may know from the rising of the sun, and from the west, that there is none beside me. I am the LORD, and there is none else."

Isaiah 44:28 "That said of Cyrus, He is my shepherd, and shall perform all my pleasure: even saying to Jerusalem, You shall be built; and to the temple, Your foundation shall be laid."

150 years before he was born, Isaiah prophesied about a king named Cyrus who would rebuild Jerusalem and its Temple. The Jews showed him these scriptures, and he responded immediately with the following decree:

Ezra 1:2-4 " ²Thus said Cyrus king of Persia, The LORD God of heaven has given me all the kingdoms of the earth; and he has charged me to build him an house at Jerusalem, which is in Judah. ³Who is there among you of all his people? his God be with him, and let him go up to Jerusalem, which is in Judah, and build the house of the LORD God of Israel, (he is the God,) which is in Jerusalem. ⁴And whoever remains in any place where he sojournes, let the men of his place help him with silver, and with gold, and with goods, and with beasts, beside the freewill offering for the house of God that is in Jerusalem."

These dates are from Bishop Ussher. There are many arguments against these dates because they place Artaxerxes decree in his 20th year to Nehemiah to rebuild the wall of Jerusalem in the year 454 BC which makes it 483 years until "Messiah the Prince" is baptized in 29 AD.

They differ from the dates from Ptolemy because he did not include co-regency. But historians Heroditus and Thucydides who lived during this time both attest to co-regency being common. Heroditus wrote it was customary for a king to name his successor before he went to war. Thucydides stated Artaxerxes began to reign with his father in Xerxes 12th year, when Artaxerxes was 16 years old.

The 3rd group returned under the decree of Artaxerxes.*



In the early 1900's the League of Nations began to consider territory for Jews to settle. In 1948 Israel became a nation again.

*2300 – 333 = 1967 Israel captured Jerusalem during 6-day war.

"The June 1967 War was a watershed event in the history of Israel and the Middle East. After only six days of fighting, Israel had radically altered the political map of the region. By June 13, Israeli forces had captured the Golan Heights from Syria, Sinai and the Gaza Strip from Egypt, and all of Jerusalem and the West Bank from Jordan. The new territories more than doubled the size of pre1967 Israel, placing under Israel's control more than 1 million Palestinian Arabs. In Israel, the ease of the victory, the expansion of the state's territory, and the reuniting of Jerusalem, the holiest place in Judaism, permanently altered political discourse." from Israel website




Since Jerusalem's destruction in 70 AD, Israel ceased to be a nation even though many Jews remained in the land the Romans called Palestine.

In the late 1800's Americans were praying and providing for a future state of the Jewish people.

When WWI began, Europe was already looking at how to carve up the Ottoman Empire. During WWII the British ruled Palestine with Jerusalem as its capital. But the temple mount was held by the Muslims. Jews came to Israel by droves because of the German Holocaust.

In 1948 Russia immediately recognized the new state of Israel.




In 1967 6-day war, Israel gains Sinai Peninsula, Gaza Strip, Golan Heights*, and West Bank. Most importantly they took Jerusalem and the Temple Mount.

Under Russian threat, Israel returned the Temple Mount to Muslim authorities, the Golan Heights to Syria for supposed peace. Israel kept the West Bank.

Jordan's kinglater threw out the violent PLO, and now they're convincing the world to give them yet another state carved out of Israel.

But let's back up just a bit.



"The international community, including the emerging Arab nations, recognized Israel at the 1919 Paris Peace Conference, which was held by the victorious Allies in order to settle international questions after the 1918 armistice ended World War I. The head of the Arab delegation, Emir Feisal, great-grandfather of Abdallah, the future king of Jordan, agreed that "Palestine" would be the Jewish homeland.

Feisal accepted the <u>British Balfour Declaration of Nov. 2, 1917</u>, which afforded recognition to a Jewish national homeland, and agreed with the Zionist delegation, stating, "All such measures shall be adopted as we afford the fullest guarantee of carrying into effect the British Government's Balfour Declaration." Emir Feisal confirmed this determination in a March 3, 1919 letter to Harvard Law Professor, and later US Supreme Court Justice, Felix Frankfurter, to whom he wrote: "Our deputation here in Paris is fully acquainted with the proposals submitted by the Zionist organization to the Peace Conference, and we regard them as modest and proper. We will do our best, insofar as we are concerned, to help them through. We will wish the Jews a most hearty welcome home."

In exchange for Arab recognition of Israel, the Allied powers, in 1919, agreed to the eventual sovereignty of almost 20 Arab states, covering vast oil-rich lands, after a period of mandatory oversight by European powers. The Europeans would proceed to draw the borders of their respective mandates and, in essence, create the system of Arab states that would emerge out of the remnants of the old Turkish Ottoman Empire. In 1922, a couple of years after the Conference, in a land for peace deal, the British would split Mandatory Palestine into an Arab and a Jewish Mandate using the Jordan River as the line of demarcation. The Arabs were granted East Palestine, or Transjordan, which would later become Arab Jordan while West Palestine, or Cis-Jordan, would become the Jewish National homeland of Israel." By Chuck Morse April 14, 2006

Isaiah 66:8 "Who has heard such a thing? who has seen such things? Shall the earth be made to bring forth in one day? or **shall a nation be born at once**? for as soon as Zion travailed, she brought forth her children."

Theodor Herzl wrote a book, the Jewish State in the 1800's, and promoted the concept of Zionism.

The plight of the Russian Jews immigrating to America touched the hearts of Christians like D.L. Moody and William Blackstone who held a conference and wrote a petition to restore Palestine to Jews.

It read, in part: "Why shall not the powers which under the treaty of Berlin, in 1878, gave Bulgaria to the Bulgarians and Servia to the Servians now give Palestine back to the Jews?...These provinces, as well as Romania, Montenegro, and Greece, were wrested from the Turks and given to their natural owners. Does not Palestine as rightfully belong to the Jews?"


The Hebrew word 'Aliyah' means 'ascent', and refers to the return of Jews to their land. The Romans named their land Palestine.

1st -3rd Aliyah's were mostly Jews from Russia, the 4th, mostly from Poland and Hungary.

The League of Nations made Palestine a British mandate in 1922.

The Fifth Aliyah of the 1930's brought over 250,000 Jews from Germany. Then the British made it illegal for the Jews to immigrate as a concession to Germany, but still many came.

The Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered in 1947, and photographed in February 1948, and the Arab-Israeli War erupted in March.



Hebrews from all over the globe have returned to Israel as God foretold. This is called "Aliyah" in Hebrew.*




When the Ottoman Empire was carved up, Palestine's designated boundaries included quite a bit of land.

- *After Israel won the war in 1967 they were pressured to giving up over 80% of their land.
- Shortly after the 6-day war, Israel returned the Sinai Peninsula to Egypt for peace. Now only the light blue area is considered Israel's land by the UN.
- *On October 6, 1973 on Yom Kippur, Egypt and Syria led a surprise attack against Israel. And Israel tromped on them.
- Joel 3:1-2 "¹For, behold, in those days, and in that time, when I shall bring again the captivity of Judah and Jerusalem, ²I will also gather all nations, and will bring them down into the valley of Jehoshaphat, and will plead with them there for my people and for my heritage Israel, whom they have scattered among the nations, and parted my land".

The winged lion* represents England. In 1189 AD at the coronation of Richard the Lionhearted, unexpected persecution of the Jews broke out in England. Most Jewish houses in London were burned, and many Jews killed. All possessions of the Jews were claimed by the Crown. Richard's successor relieved the Jews of more than 8 million marks. England lost it's American colonies (eagle wings)* in 1783. (Rev. 12:14) American wilderness of protection of the Jews.

Then the Russian bear* came devouring much flesh in 1880. "Between 1929 and 1953 the state created by **Lenin** and set in motion by **Stalin** deprived 21.5 **million** Soviet citizens of their lives." - Dmitri Volkogonov. Many fled to Israel.

Germany began its persecution of Jews in 1933 and killed six million Jews by the end of WWII. After Hitler's defeat it was controlled by four* (wings) commanders. Many Jews fled to Palestine. The ten-horned monster* is a Muslim conglomerate which has persecuted Jews. PLO attacks began in 1970's.

In one sense, God has had enough of the abominations which have taken place in the temple and in Jerusalem where He placed His Name, and He needs some time for the whole sanctuary idea to be cleansed. He uses Gentiles to trod upon the Jews and the temple mount.

He also causes unbelief upon Israel in part until Gentiles are saved.

Daniel 8:20-22 "20The ram which you saw having two horns are the kings of Media and Persia. 21And the rough goat is the king of Grecia: and the great horn that is between his eyes is the first king. 22Now that being broken, whereas four stood up for it, four kingdoms shall stand up out of the nation, but not in his power."

Daniel's link from Isreal's past to the future

Daniel 8:23-26 "23And in the latter time of their kingdom, when the transgressors are come to the full, a king of fierce countenance, and understanding dark sentences, shall stand up. 24And his power shall be mighty, but not by his own power: and he shall destroy wonderfully, and shall prosper, and practice, and shall destroy the mighty and the holy people. 25And through his policy also he shall cause craft to prosper in his hand; and he shall magnify himself in his heart, and by peace shall destroy many: he shall also stand up against the Prince of princes; but he shall be broken without hand. 26And the vision of the evening and the morning which was told is true: why shut you up the vision; for it shall be for many days."

After Alexander the Great's death, his kingdom was split between his four generals. From one of their kingdoms (Syria) will emerge "a king of fierce countenance" (Little horn) "when the transgressors come to the full". *Transgressors* is *paw-shah'*

A primitive root [rather identical with H6585 (stride, rush on) through the idea of <u>expansion</u>]; to <u>break away (from just authority)</u>, that is, *trespass*, *apostatize*, *quarrel:* - offend, rebel, revolt, transgress (-ion, -or).

The Muslims have "broken away" from the former USSR and have expanded their territiories. They have begun wars around the world to expand Islam.

This leads to the study of the 4th beast and the "little horn".
